In 1984, it became a Post Graduate College with the affiliation to C.C.S. University, Meerut. In April 2007, the college was accredited B+ and in 2010, it was awarded College with Potential for Excellence. In 2015, this college has been accredited 'A' grade by NAAC. 


## Workshop/Symposium/








## Faculty Development Programmes & other Capacity Building Programmes for Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff
