In 1984, it became a Post Graduate College with the affiliation to C.C.S. University, Meerut. In April 2007, the college was accredited B+ and in 2010, it was awarded College with Potential for Excellence. In 2015, this college has been accredited 'A' grade by NAAC. With twelve U.G. and ten P.G. programs in Arts faculty, U.G. & P.G. in Commerce, bachelors in science and education and accommodating more than 3000 students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff, the College marches ahead towards the realization of its goals and objectives of uplifting the rural and urban background students educationally, morally and socially. 






















Faculty Development & Other Capacity Building Programmes For Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff
