In 1940, it was upgraded to high School and in 1952 up to intermediate. In 1962, the college gained the status of a degree college and got affiliated to Agra University. In 1984, it became a post graduate college with the affiliation to C.C.S. University, Meerut. In April 2007, the college was accredited B+ and in 2010, it was awarded College with Potential for Excellence. In 2015, this college was accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC. With twelve U.G. and ten P.G. programs in Arts faculty, U.G. & P.G. in Commerce, bachelor's degrees in science and education and accommodating more than 3000 students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff, the college marches ahead towards the realization of its goals and objectives of uplifting the rural and urban background students educationally, morally and socially. 

# Seminars & Conferences

A national workshop was organized on the occasion of "Human Rights Day" by the Department of Political science on the topic "Contemporary issues and challenges of human Rights in India" on the 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2023. The chief speaker professor M.P Venna explained the legal perspectives of human rights and its importance to the students. A total of 107 students participated in the program.



A one-day national seminar on "Contribution of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel in Indian Integration" was organized by the Department of Political science on 31st of October 2023. The chief speaker Professor Pankaj Sharma informed the students about the life and thoughts of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and his contributions in making India integrated. A total of 44 students participated in the seminar.



A national seminar on the topic "Changing Nature of Marriage, Family and Kinship in 21st Century" was organized by the Department of collaboration Sociology in with Indian Sociological Society (RC 2) on the 3rd of October 2023 in hybrid mode. The keynote speaker, Professor Mahesh Shukla convenor RC 2, Indian sociological society delivered a lecture on the future of marriage and family in India. The presidential address was delivered by professor Alok Head of Sociology department, CCS University Meerut.



A seminar was organized by the Department of Economics in collaboration with Department of Commerce on the topic "Ideas for the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047" on the 16<sup>th</sup> of December 2023. The seminar discussed the importance of compilation of innovative ideas, networking and collaboration, awareness, and sensitization in emerging India as a developed nation. A total of 85 students participated in the program.





A one-day seminar was organized by Road Safety Club on the topic "Road safety: Safe Life" on the 16<sup>th</sup> of December 2023. The resource person told the students about road safety rules and first aid and encouraged them to follow these rules. They motivated the students to raise awareness about road safety among the parents, neighborhood and community. A total of 42 students participated in this seminar.



A one-day seminar was organized by Eco Club and Rangers committee in collaboration with Association on the topic Jagruk Nagrik "Environmental Protection, Women Empowerment and Sustainable Development" on 18th of November 2023. The key note speaker, Dr. Anil Prakash Joshi, Padma Shri Awardee environmentalist threw light on the subject of Environmental Protection and sustainable development. He informed the students about the active role of women in environmental protection and sustainable development. A total of 102 students participated in this seminar.



A one-day seminar was organized by Road safety club on the topic "Road safety: Rules and Precautions" on 08th of February 2024. The resource persons educated the students about the Good Samaritan which provides legal protestion to those assisting injured individuals in emergency. They explained the students about various road safety rules and new provisions. A total of 80 students participated in this seminar.



A one-day seminar was organized by B.Ed Department on the topic "International Property Rights: Issues and Challenges" on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April 2024. Resource persons Professor Dinesh Kumar and Dr Rajiv Kaushik elaborated in detail about the patent process, it types, issues related to patent, and time period of different patents etc. A total of 30 students participated in the seminar.





A seminar was organized by the Department of Economics on "Bharat ke Vartman Paripeksh mein Arthik Samasyaon Ka Adhyayan" on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of November 2023. The students were told in the seminar about various economic issues and Indian economic problems such as poverty, income inequality, unemployment, inflation, corruption and inadequate infrastructure. A total 24 students participated in the program.

A conference was organized by Prahari Club on the topic "Effects of Drug Abuse on youth" on the 30th of September 2023. The chief speaker, Dr Vinita Sharma emphasized on the increasing effect of drug addiction prevalent in the society. She identified drug abused not only as an addiction but also a mental disorder from which protection and prevention is possible. A total of 40 students benefited with this program.





A one-day seminar on Gender Equality, Health Promotion, and Nutrition Awareness of Girls was organized on 21st October 2023 by the Department of Home Science under the Mission Shakti program. The program made students the aware gender equality and nutrition. A total 83 of students participated in this seminar.

A seminar on the topic "The Importance of Course Grains in diet" was organized by Home Science Department in collaboration with Paryavaran Swachhata Club on the 21st of December 2023. The program educated the students about the importance of consuming coarse grains for good health. A total of 70 students participated in the program.







# Workshops & Symposium

A three-day workshop on Self-Defence was organized from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2023 by the Department of Physical Education. A total of 20 students participated in this program. The program taught the students to lead safe, happy and independent life. Shweta Shami Self-Defence Instructor and Mr. Ajay Kumar, Central Coach taught Self Defence techniques to the students.



A Six-day self-defence training program was organized by the Department of Physical Education in collaboration with Rangers Committee from 11<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2023, under which instructor Mr. Sanjay Kumar and Kumari Rajeshwari from CTSF, SSG, (Greater Noida) taught defense against physical attack. Soft skills and controlling technique were also taught to the students in the workshop.



A one-day workshop was organized to celebrat by the Department of Physical Education and Sports on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2023 to celebrate International Yoga Day, in which the students participated for physical, mental, emotional and spiritual development. A total of 187 students participated in the program.



A one-day workshop on the topic "Suicide Prevent" was organized by the Department of Psychology in under the Aegis of Mental Health Mission India on the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2023. A total of 76 students participated in the program. The resource persons Swati Yadav and Ayesha Saifi gave detailed information about the causes, symptom and prevention of suicide.





A one-day workshop on "Fit India" (Yoga and Meditation) was organized by the Department of Psychology on the 5<sup>th</sup> of December 2023. Yogacharya Renu Mudit Bansal trained the students through to connect with their inner self yoga. She elaborated how yoga connects body to the mind, and mind to the soul, and soul to the universe. A total of 46 students participated in the program.



On September 1, 2023, the Department of Music conducted a workshop entitled "Sangeet Mein Rojgar." The facilitator provided insights to the students regarding various career opportunities available in the field of music, including roles such as music composer, music educator, music software developer, music director, and sound engineer, among others.



On 16<sup>th</sup> December 2023, a symposium on Vijay Diwas under the aegis of Mission Shakti 2.0 was organized by the Department of Sanskrit. This symposium served as a fitting tribute to the heroes of the 1971 war and a platform for meaningful discussions on India's defence and strategic priorities. It reinforced the importance of remembering the glorifying past while preparing for the future, ensuring that the sacrifices of the soldiers continue to inspire and guide the nation.



A workshop titled "Table Ke Varno ki Nikaasi" was conducted by the Department of Music on October 6, 2023. Dr. Anita Kashyap, the resource person, emphasized the significance of establishing Taal in enhancing Verna, which in turn influences the type of song and the associated rituals. A total of 26 students took part in the event.





A workshop hosted by the Department of Music on the subject "Sitar Vadan Mein Bolo ka Mahatva" took place on October 19, 2023. Dr. Suman Lata Sharma discussed the different components of Raga and their significance. She emphasized the critical nature of various elements of the raga, including the fundamental notes, Jodi, Mukhda, Alap, and others. The role of Bol in Sitar playing was highlighted as particularly essential. A total of 24 students took part in this event.



A workshop was conducted by the Department of Music on the subject "Adhunik that Raag Paddhati ka Mahatva" on March 30, 2024. The resource person, Dr. Kiran, informed the students that the that Raag system facilitates a clearer understanding of the arrangement and sequence of the Swar in Ragas. A total of 25 individuals participated in this event.



A workshop on "Sangeet aur Samaj" was organized by the Department of Music on the 28<sup>th</sup> of March 2024. Dr. Radha Rani, resource person told the students about the relationship of Music and Society and said that both are complementary to each other. A total of 25 students participated in this program.



A workshop was organized on the 13<sup>th</sup> of February 2024 at the occasion of "Naman Divas and Vasant Panchmi" by Eco club and Rangers committee in collaboration with Jagruk Nagrik Association. The resource person motivated the students to adopt sustainable practices and value mother Earth. He also informed about various remedial plants such as stevia, lemongrass, aloe vera, etc. A total of 65 students participated in the program.





On 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023, a workshop was organized on the occasion of "International vulture awareness day" by Eco club and Rangers committee in collaboration with Social Forestry Division. The resource person, Dr. Saloni threw light on all aspects of vultures and presented a documentary. Another speaker, Dr. Anshul Chawla told that vultures are natural cleaners but slowly their species are getting extinct. A total of 102 students participated in this workshop.



On 09th August 2023, 'सशक्त' Women Study cell has organized an awareness workshop in collaboration with 'ORGAN INDIA' under the aegis of the National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO). The motive of this session was to make participants aware of the value of organ and eye donation. Total 40 students participated in the workshop.



A workshop titled "Sangeet Mein Anushasan ka Mahatva" was conducted by the Department of Music on October 13, 2023. Professor Jaya Sharma, the resource person, emphasized to the students that practice is crucial within the field of music, as it enhances creativity and focus. She explained that discipline enables musicians to develop new tones and melodies, which is vital for achieving proficiency and technical skill. A total of 35 students took part in this event.



On September 19, 2023, an insightful workshop titled 'परवाह': A Self- Care Workshop" took place at Ramlal Agarwal Hall. The distinguished speaker for the workshop was Dr. Bhawna Gandhi, a renowned nutritionist and the founder of Santript. The workshop provided a platform for the attendees to delve into the intricacies of maintaining a healthy being and emotional balance. A total of 78 students participated in the programme.

Advocate Sylvia Samuel, the chief speaker of the workshop discussed 4 pillars of child rights, Juvenile Justice Act, POCSO Act through an interesting PPT presentation. Then Komal movie (a movie on child sexual abuse) was shown to the students. Also discussion on various case studies was done by Adv. Samuel.



On the 21st of February 2024, on the occasion of mother language day, a symposium was organized by the Department of Hindi on the topic "Vichar Gosthi". The resource person told the students about the importance of Hindi language and to be proud of our mother tongue. A total of 46 students participated in the program.



A symposium was organized on the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 2024 by the Department of Hindi on the topic "Hindi bhasha ka Antarrashtriy Mahatva Evam Swaroop" on Vishva Hindi Divas.
