Dr. Mamta Singh, Dr. Soniya Gupta, Dr. Sarika Sharma, and Dr. Anju Gupta have been welcomed as the new members of the IQAC cell. After that newly elected IQAC Coordinator presented the previous year's report to all the members of the committee and the agenda of the meeting in brief.
- * The committee assigned Dr. Huma Masood to prepare the Academic Calendar for the upcoming session and the same will be placed before the IQAC coordinator and principal for approval within a week.
- * The committee also come up with the idea to conduct an Orientation program for all new entrants to familiarize them with the college environment. It is also suggested that an orientation program for NSS and Rangers must be commenced.
- * The committee requested Dr. Huma Masood, Chief Proctor to address the newly elected Chief prefect and prefects and explain the code of conduct.
- * Dr. Deepti Kaushik informed that a systematic Mentor-Mentee program is going to be introduced in the college from the current session. It is being decided that a Mentorship program for faculty members will be commenced. Dr. Deepti Kaushik assigned Dr. Anju Gupta for the task.
- Further, Dr. Deepti Kaushik invited suggestions for celebrating the 150th birth anniversary of M.K. Gandhi. Some members suggested organizing a seminar on Gandhi's ideology. Further, it was decided to conduct a threeday celebration including various activities on 2nd October 2019.

- ♣ A three-day orientation program was organized from 5/08/2019 to 07/08/2019. The program was considerate for newly admitted students to familiarize themselves with the college environment.255 students have participated in the program and stated their valuable feedback. On 10/08/2019, an orientation program was also convened by all three units of NSS in which 143 students participated enthusiastically. The main purpose of this program was to make students aware of the History, structure, and importance of NSS and motivate them to register for the same. The Ranger unit of the college also decided to coordinate an orientation session for the students in the first week of October 2019.
- ♣ On 22nd July 2019, a copy of the academic calendar has been circulated to all the departments after getting approval from the IQAC coordinator and Principal.
- The Proctor committee has successfully organized the inauguration ceremony on 28/08/2019 and elected the chief prefect as well as other prefects for the present session. Afterward, the Chief Proctor addressed the newly appointed prefects and explained the code of conduct of the college in detail. The duties were allocated to them as per their free periods.
- ♣ The Mentorship program was initiated by the institution at the departmental level. Every faculty member continues to mentor and guide a group of 25 students through the session. Considering the fact that our students come from diverse cultural and economic backgrounds and have varied aspiration levels and abilities, each member counsels these students so that they can take informed career decisions as well as opt for secondary courses that can help in their skill enhancement. Furthermore, faculty members help these students tide over the psychological and personal dilemmas that are common at this stage of their life. Hence, the mentorship program was carried out formally on the last Saturday of every month.
- As decided in the meeting, the "Gandhian Study Center" has concerted a three-day celebration on the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi which includes an Inter-university Poster Competition, Slogan Competition, and a National-level seminar on 4G Gandhi, Ganga, Gau, Gaon. More than 100 students and faculty members have taken part spiritedly in the celebration.
